

# NOTICE OF INTENT TO DIGITIZE BACK ISSUES OF *ÑAWPA PACHA*

With the help of Maney Publishing, the Institute of Andean Studies intends to make available in electronic form all of the back issues of *Ñawpa Pacha*. We hope that easy access to previously published papers, of which few subscribers and Institute members will have copies, will be a considerable enhancement of the benefits of institutional subscription to the journal and membership in the Institute.

The current procedure is for authors to assign copyright for both print and electronic publication to the Institute. This does not limit an author's ability to reuse material, but ensures that Maney, on our behalf, can protect the copyright internationally. The works that we published in the early years of the journal were not administered in this way, nor was specific permission sought to obtain electronic rights; indeed, the very concept of electronic rights was scarcely imaginable at the start of our publication. It would exceed the resources available to the Institute to contact all the authors who have previously contributed to *Ñawpa Pacha* and obtain their permission (or that of their estate's executor, where an author is deceased) to republish their work electronically.

We are therefore disseminating this notice to ask for any authors who object to the proposed digitization and distribution of back issues of *Ñawpa Pacha* to let us know as soon as possible. In the absence of a response, we will take permission as given. If it is withdrawn, we will reluctantly omit the author's work from the electronic back archive. This will create a hole in the record, but we will respect the decision.

We expect this notice will be seen and read by most people involved in the activities of the Institute, and we would be grateful if you could draw it to the attention of your colleagues. We will proceed with this project in the next few weeks, and need to ensure that notice of our intention is disseminated widely.
